WHAT IS TROY IODIN SPRAY SKIN AND WOUND DRESSING?

Troy Iodin Spray Skin and Wound Dressing is an aid in the treatment and prevention of skin infections caused by bacteria and fungi in dogs, cats, horses, cattle and sheep.

Active Ingredient: 5 g/ L iodine (as povidone-iodine)

Poison Schedule: Unscheduled

Physical Description: Reddish-brown liquid free from any suspended matter.

HOW TO USE TROY IODIN SPRAY SKIN AND WOUND DRESSING?

Shake well before use.

Application: Hold pack approximately 10 cm from the skin and spray on affected area.

Restraints: Government regulations limit iodine residues in milk. When used on teats and udder wounds, teats must be cleansed and dried prior to milking to reduce iodine residues in milk.

Precautions: Do not apply to eyes or mucous membranes. Repeated use on open wounds is not recommended.

Withholding Periods:

- MEAT: Zero (0) days.
- MILK: Zero (0) days.

Trade Advice - Export Slaughter Interval (ESI):

An ESI has not been established for this product.

Storage: Store below 30 °C (room temperature).
